Forest Homecare Chelmsford are now part of this scheme that protects vulnerable people.

Keep Safe is a free scheme that helps vulnerable residents to feel safer and more confident whilst out in the city. Shops, businesses and other public buildings will let them use a phone or make a call for them if they need help while they are out and about in the city.

Forest Homecare Chelmsford are now showing a Keep Safe sticker in their window to identify that they are part of the scheme and all the staff have been given information on what to do if someone shows them a Keep Safe card or key ring and appears to be in distress or asks for their help.

Safe havens have been identified all across the city, where people can go if they find themselves in trouble for any reason. For example, they may have become separated from their family or friends, be disorientated, may have lost something, feel ill or unsafe or they may have been a victim of crime.
